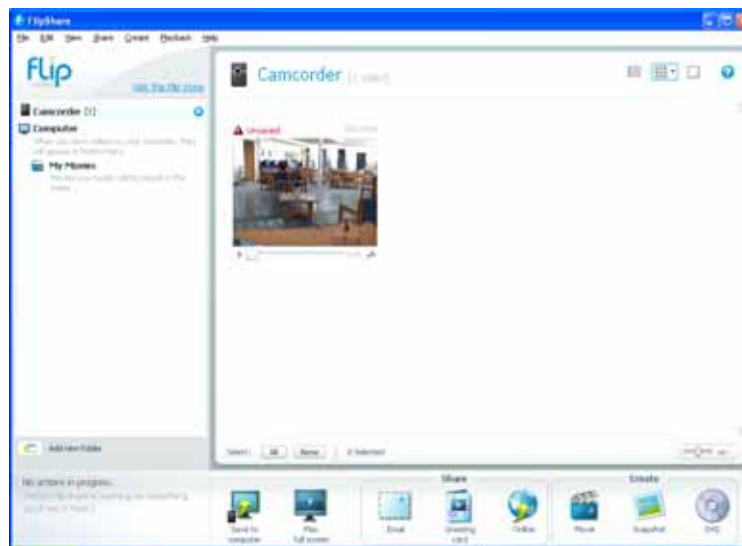

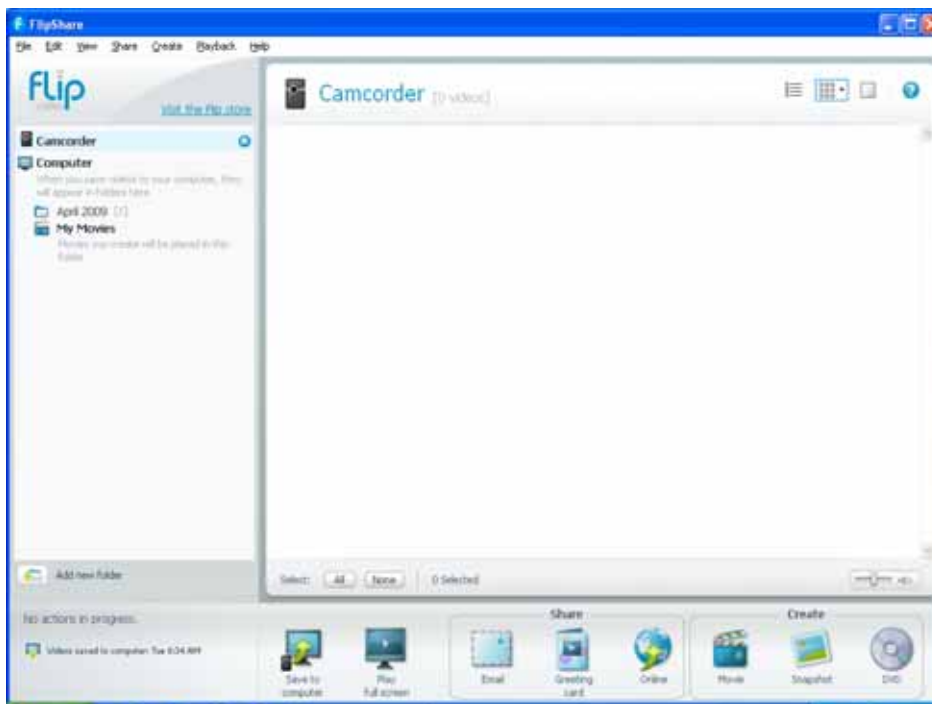
Downloading FLIP Videos to Your Computer

(NOTE: FLIP Video Software will first need to be installed on the computer)

- FLIP Recorder is turned off
- Plug USB cable into one end of FLIP and the other end into computer USB port.
- FLIP Recorder will power on and FLIP Share software will automatically start up.
- You will see the following screen:



- If you choose to save the video on your computer, click on the video clip(s) to select and click on **Save to Computer**. (To select multiple, Shift/Click or Ctrl/Click)
- A folder will be created with the Month/Year as the name and the video will be copied to this folder. Folder is located in: **My Documents\My Videos\FliShare Data**
- If you wish to remove the video from the FLIP Recorder, put a check in the appropriate box from the pop-up window – Remove videos from camcorder after saving.
- At this point, you can click on the folder to view your video. When you click on the folder, your video(s) will appear in the window and a small trash can icon will appear to the right of the folder in case you want to delete the folder.

- To remove your FLIP, do the same that you do for a Flash Drive: Click on the **Safely Remove Hardware** icon in the Windows notification area (bottom right of your screen) of your task bar.

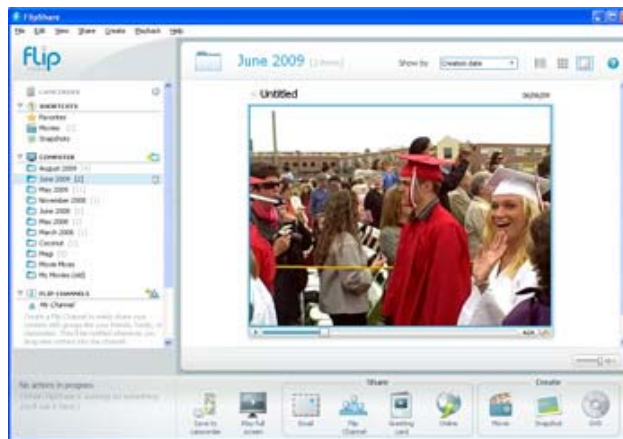

 - PC: 2.0 GHz Intel Pentium 4 or faster processor, Windows XP SP2 with 512 MB RAM or Vista with 1 GB RAM, and USB port.
 - Macintosh: 1.0 GHz PowerPC G4, Intel Core or faster processor, 512MB of RAM, OS X Tiger 10.4 or Leopard 10.5, and USB port.
